Plan	Action Taken
Prospectus	The prospectus containing updated information regarding admission, courses offered, fee structure, faculty profile, institutional facilities, and student support services was prepared and uploaded on the college website before the commencement of admissions.
Admission, Committees & Teaching	Admission committees were constituted well in advance and admissions were conducted smoothly as per the schedule notified by the Directorate of Higher Education. All statutory and Institutional committees were reconstituted, and regular teaching commenced according to the academic calendar.
Time Table	Department-wise and faculty-wise timetables were prepared by the Time Table Committee and made available to all stakeholders through the college notice board and website.
