

The objective of the program was to raise awareness among students about environmental and wildlife protection, as well as



सार्थक है, जिसकी पूर्ण में भी। आधुनिक तकनीकों के साथ पेन, पेपर तकनीक का सदुपयोग करना आवश्यक होता है, जिसमें साक्षात्कार के पाठ लिखने में अहमानी हो जाती है। किशन श्रीमान ने बताया कि साक्षात्कार के दौरान संयम, शिष्ट व जिस भी शक्तिशाली का साक्षात्कार लिया जा रहा हो उसके प्रति सम्मान को भावना होना भी अति आवश्यक है। साक्षात्कार का पाठ लिखते समय भी गिव रिस्पेक्ट, टेक रिस्पेक्ट वाली धारणा का अनुसरण करना आवश्यक होता है ताकि साक्षात्कार लेने वाले और देने वाले में समरसता बनी रहे। कार्यशाला में बिंदु मूर्धवंशी ने भविष्य में होने वाली कार्यशालाओं की जानकारी दी। प्राध्यापी डा. उरसेम ने बताया कि महाविद्यालय और हिमतरु के मध्य हुए एमओयू के तहत छात्रों के
