A meeting of the IQAC members was held in the Principal's office under the Chairmanship of Dr. Urmilata. Following members were present in the meeting.

Following are the minutes of the meeting to discuss the Institutional Development Plan for the Session 2024-25.

① A meeting was held on 18th Nov, 2024 between Development Officer Sh. Vivek Sharma and Principal Dr. Urmilata to connect college with industries so as to generate opportunities of self employment. Taking it a step ahead, it was decided in this meeting that for session 2024-25, the college will collaborate with Development officer HP Khadi and Village Industries Board Kullu by signing an MOU with them for next two years. The MOU will help provide college students to identify various skills like that of bee keeping, steel fabrication, mobile repair, videography etc.

② It was unanimously decided to take up the Pine-needle project to a higher scale by registering the college under NABARD. The college will submit an extensive project of Pine-needle to NABARD (NabSkillrural.org). The college will also organize an ^{one-day} online workshop of 7-10 days as the prior ^{one-day} workshop organized under Community Development and Engagement Cell was highly appreciated by the Director Higher Education.

- ③ As per meeting between Conservator of Forest, Kullu and Prof. Rattan of G.C. Panassa on 19th Nov, 2024, it was decided to make the meeting fruitful by creating a 'Biodiversity Club' in the college. In the IBAAC meeting it was decided to nominate Prof. Rattan and Prof. Indira Singh as members of this group from teaching faculty of the college. It was decided that for the upcoming session students will be enrolled in this group to carry out various activities which will be organised by the Forest Department from time to time.
- ④ In the meeting, it was decided to collaborate with other colleges of our vicinity so that a joint effort can be made to encourage literary, cultural and social efforts among the students. The common group has been tentatively titled as "Manthan". The aim of the Manthan group will be cross-exchange of students of G.C. Panassa, G.C. Haripur, G.C. Kullu, G.C. Sainj and G.C. Banjar. This exchange will provide wider exposure and learning experience to students of these colleges.
- ⑤ Taking the MOU signed between G.C. Panassa and Himant Publication a step ahead, it was decided to contribute in bringing out the next edition of Himant magazine which will be dedicated to Environment and Indian Knowledge System. This step will be in consonance with the NEP which will bring students closer ancient Indian traditions and customs.
