

IQAC/NAAC Quality Initiatives Introduced in 2025–26 and Continued in 2026–27

These initiatives have been institutionalized and are being effectively continued and strengthened during the Academic Session 2026–27 to foster academic excellence, cultural preservation, constitutional values, and holistic student development.

1. Open Library Initiative

The Open Library concept was introduced to promote a vibrant reading culture and self-directed learning.

Students are provided greater access to books and learning resources beyond regular classroom hours.

The initiative encourages independent learning, academic engagement, and lifelong reading habits.

2. College Museum

A College Museum has been established to preserve and showcase local history, culture, traditional artefacts, and the rich heritage of the region.

3. Trilingual Word Campaign (त्रिभाषी शब्द अभियान)

The campaign aims to enhance vocabulary, multilingual competence, and appreciation of Indian languages.

It supports the multilingual vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

4. Indian Knowledge System (IKS) Lecture Series

Regular lectures, expert talks, and interactive sessions are organized on various aspects of the Indian Knowledge System.

The lecture series familiarizes students with India's rich intellectual traditions, philosophy, literature, science, culture, and indigenous practices.

The initiative promotes interdisciplinary learning and strengthens awareness of India's knowledge heritage.

5. Installation of the Preamble to the Constitution of India

A granite pedestal displaying the Preamble to the Constitution of India has been installed at a prominent location on the college campus.

The initiative seeks to inculcate constitutional values, democratic ideals, and a sense of responsible citizenship among students.

Regular awareness activities and collective readings of the Preamble are organized to reinforce these values.

6. Art and Craft Corner

An Art and Craft Corner has been developed to provide a dedicated space for displaying students' creative works and traditional handicrafts.

The initiative encourages artistic expression, innovation, and appreciation of local art and craft traditions.

It also provides a platform to showcase students' talents during institutional and community events.
