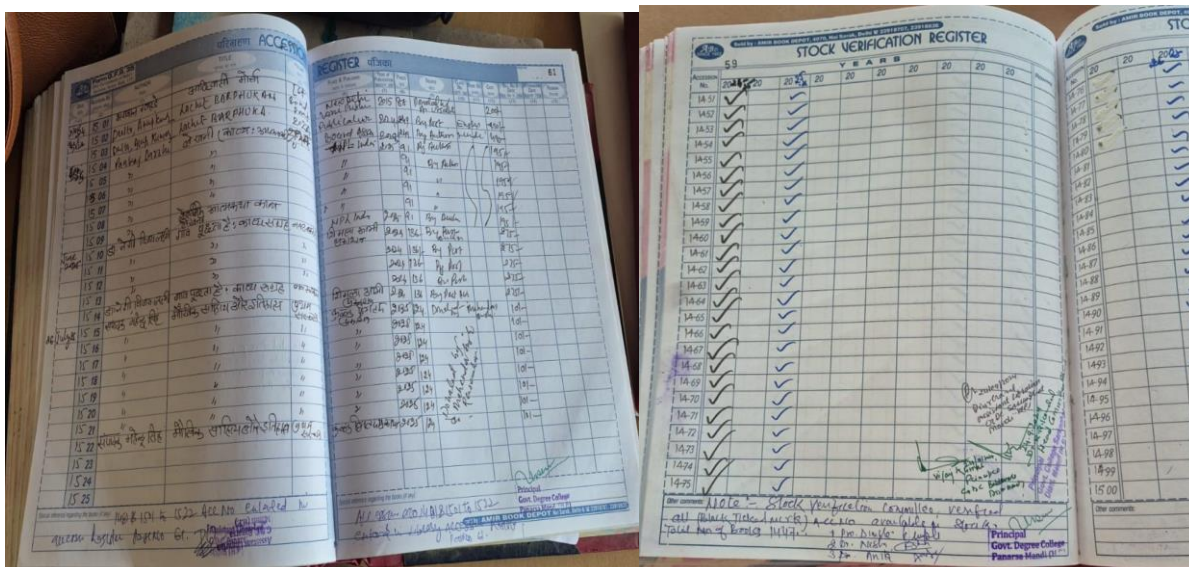

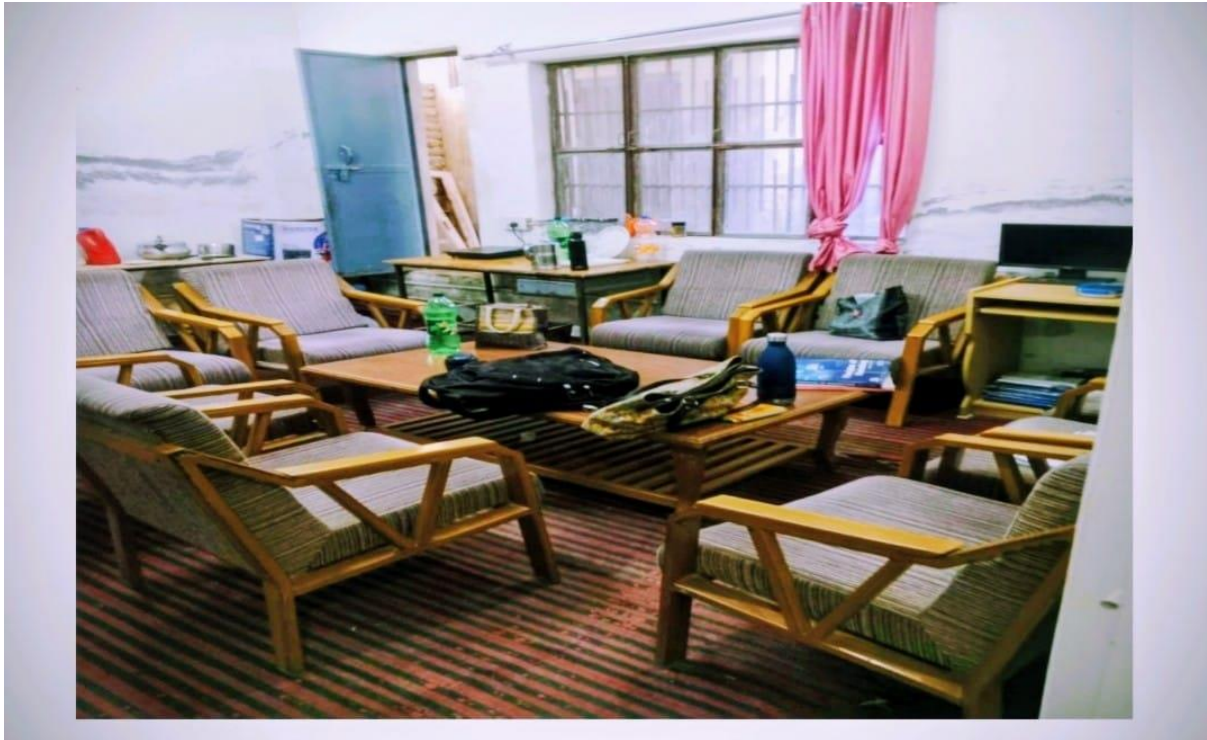
Staff Room Computer

1. All the members in the meeting agreed that vocational courses are most appropriate for students to generate more avenues of self-employment. Govt. Panara teaching faculty discussed that vocational courses in Tourism, Hospitality, Automobile, Information Technology Skills etc. are a part of school curriculum and if these courses are offered further to the students then it may benefit the students at large.
