Best Practice 1- Hindi Maha Celebration (1st September to 30th September 2024)

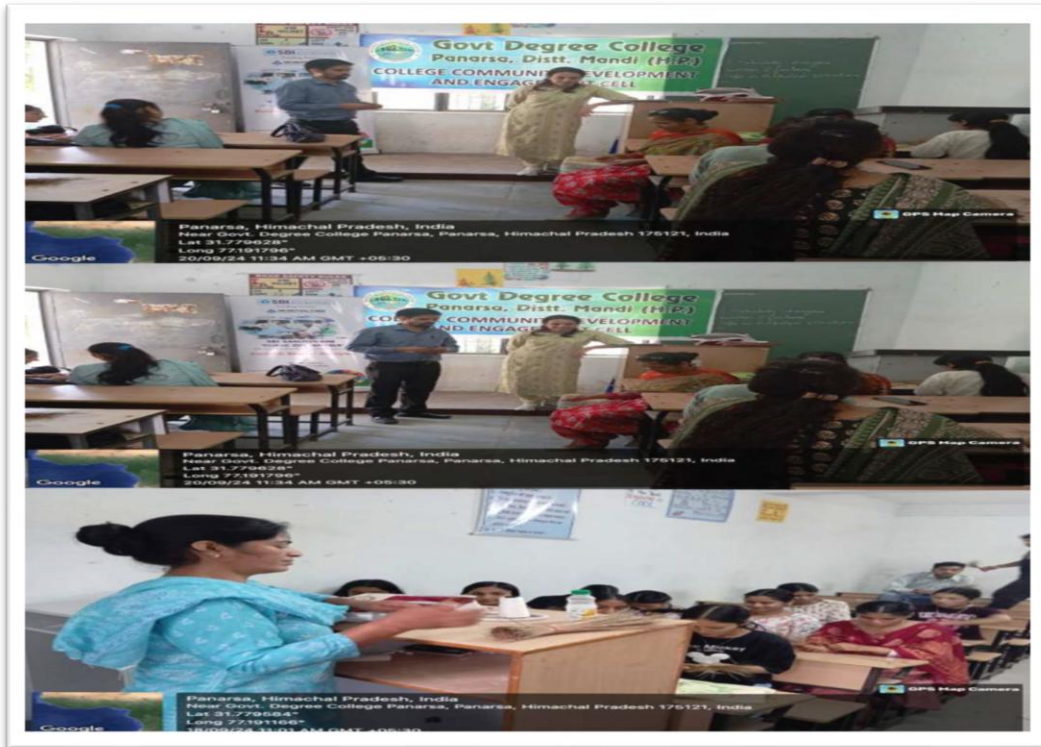
